What is required of a Summer Team member?

- To be a 24/7 ambassador for God and Adullam Camps
- Certification in First Aid – take the course before June 30, 2024, and submit proof to the Staff Captain
- Police Check – If you are 19 years of age or older, you will need to complete a police check. Submit proof to the Staff Captain by June 1, 2024. (Note that there can be a wait time of 6 weeks in some cases.)
- Canoe skills - ORCKA Level 1
- Availability for all scheduled events (see list). Be prepared to confirm your commitment to these dates at the interview¹.
- Participation in fundraising for Adullam Camps.
- Willingness to be the kind of team member that looks for ways to contribute, constantly thinking of the big picture (rather than a person with a “lone wolf” mentality, an “employee” mentality, or an “I’m entitled to...” mentality)

What can a Summer Team member expect to gain from being involved?

- Personal growth spiritually, mentally, and emotionally
- Leadership ability that can be used in your church and job throughout your life
- Experience in a notable leadership program that can be claimed on resumes and applications in the future
- The chance to make a difference in campers’ lives as you share the love of Christ throughout the summer
- Long-lasting friendships
- A summer of fun

Adullam Camps Leadership Program

- Adullam Camps’ leadership program is one-of-a-kind in North America. It uses a multi-year apprenticeship model to train young people for Christ-centered leadership in their churches, youth groups, schools, and communities. The key to the program model is the participants’ commitment to return to their sponsoring organization to fill a leadership role during the school year. During the summer, participants will build their leadership skills in a Christian summer camp environment.
- Adullam Camps’ motto succinctly captures the mission of the ministry:
To prepare God’s people for works of service so that the body of Christ might be built up. ~ Ephesians 4:12
